Duties and Responsibilities

- Draft scope of works and any other complementary documentation needed to execute ROL projects and activities to assist the GOG
- Provide technical and legal opinions and studies required by INL-G

- Prepare studies, legal opinions, and other documents as requested by the INL-G
- Prepare draft legislation, regulations, project plans or other documents as needed or as requested by INL-G
- Design and implementation of evaluation mechanisms for INL-G ROL projects and activities
- Draft scope of works and any other complementary documentation needed to execute ROL projects to assist the GOG
- A concise written report (in English and Spanish) must be delivered upon completion of assistance
