The CARSI Initiative, one of the largest and most sophisticated multi-lateral security efforts in the world, provides funding for the USG to assist the governments of the CARSI countries with police professionalization, justice sector reform, counter narcotics efforts, border security management, crime and violence prevention, and anti-corruption efforts.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide technical legal advice to CRADIC (Analysis Center), PANDA (National Anti-gang Unit) and the National Police Academy to improve effectiveness and efficiency.
- Provide training to the assigned police personnel of the following police units: of CRADIC, PANDA, Model Precinct, MOPSIC and Police Academy Instructors. This instruction will be aimed at developing specialized trainers for CRADIC, PANDA, Model Precincts and Prosecution Units.
- Provide comprehensive training in Constitutional Law, Police Laws and Regulations,
 Organized Crime Legislation and Legal Aspects of Sexual Violence.
- Prepare and develop all materials for the courses (in Spanish). At the conclusion of the training, the materials will become property of the U.S. Department of State.
- Promote the application of police procedures regarding criminal investigations and prevention entrusted to the police units.
- Provide technical advice to strengthen a case management system so that police units may conduct their investigative duties based on scientific forensic evidences.
- Provide technical advice as requested by National Civil Police or Ministry of Government and other actions as required.
- Hours for this full-time position will be the core hours of the Guatemalan interlocutors, five days a week, with a minimum of 40 hours per week.
- The position is located in Guatemala City and travel to other Police Academy locations to include Cuilapa, Huehuetenango and Salama. In-country travel will be required as part of this position and will be covered through this contract. Out-of-country travel may be required as well.
